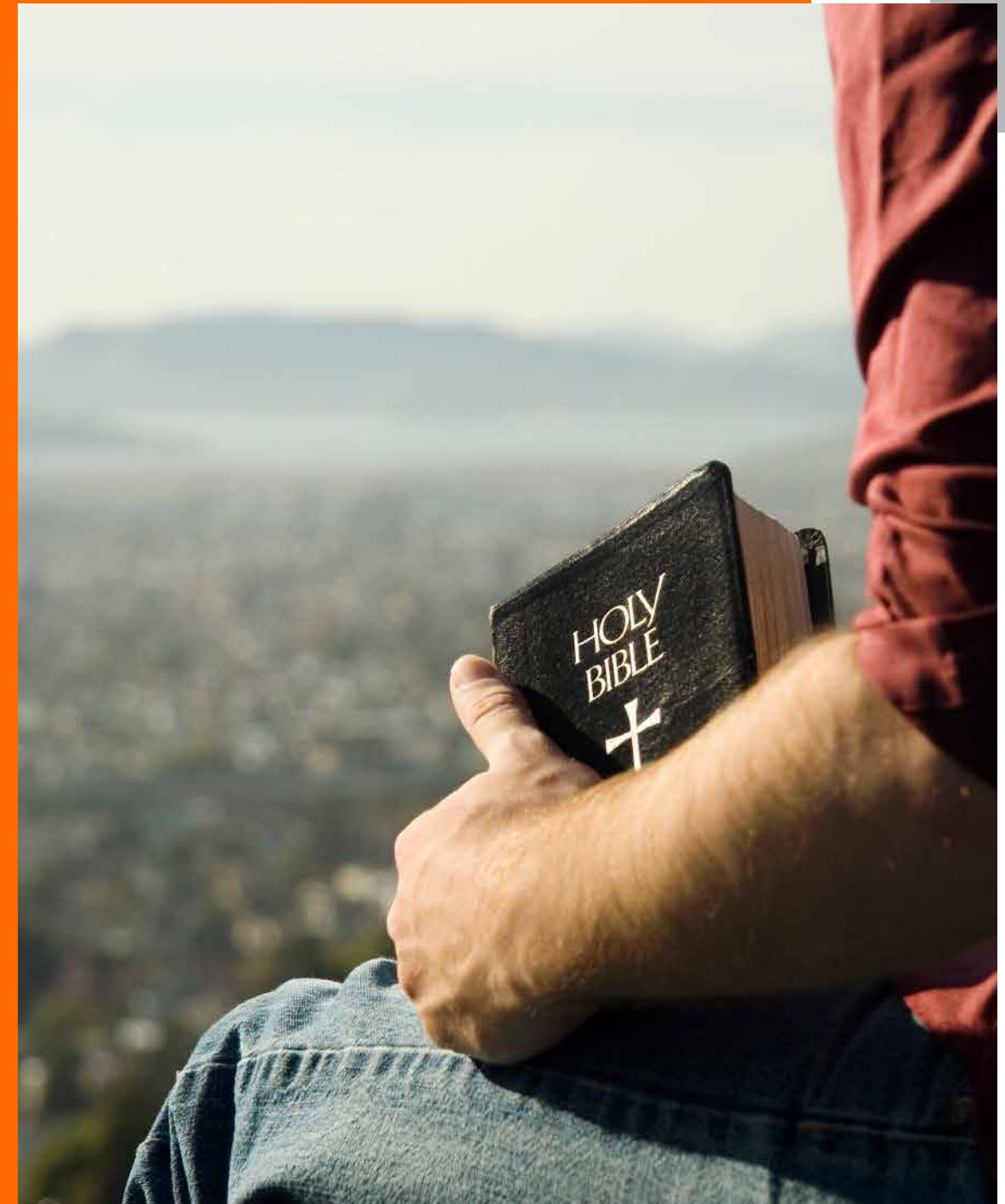
## Live a godly life

Non-Christians often look at Christians as hypocritical because we say one thing but do another. Show those close to you that you care—spend time with them, help meet their needs and offer to listen when they have problems.

You might not be able to answer all of their questions, but they can't deny the reality of what Christ has done in your life.

## Identify your mission field
